### Winemaker's Notes

Sourced from dry grown vineyards, this wine has rich aromas of blackcurrant and cherries. The palate shows juicy dark fruits with a hint of vanilla followed by mint and dark chocolate. Velvety mouth feel is followed by generous tannins leaving a lingering finish.
