WINEMAKERS NOTES

This wine from 2006 vintage is a rich, full bodied Cabernet with layers of concentrated intense dark berry fruits hints of chocolate and mint with firm tannins leaving a long lingering finish.

Renowned South Australian artist Tom Gleghorn has honoured Reillys Wines by allowing us to use one of his beautiful prints as a new wine label. Inspired when watching the preparation for an Aboriginal tribal dance, Tom has called this vibrant painting 'The Landscape Dancer'. This is a limited release wine with only 3000 numbered bottles being produced.
