


2009 Watervale Riesling

Sourced from Smyth's 41 year old Watervale vineyard to produce a delicate wine with good structure.

Lovely aromatics of blossoms, honeysuckle and green apple. The palate has fine acid structure combined with fruit to give good balance and length. A wine with exceptional character.
