WINEMAKERS NOTES

Sourced from dry grown vineyards that were planted in the 1920's, this Shiraz has layers of succulent fruit with flavours of dark berries and plum.

Open fermentation and two years maturation in American oak has resulted in a smooth, velvety texture and a hint of pepper and spice on the palate.

It has well integrated oak with a long lingering finish.

Why Stolen Block?

Fruit from one of our most exceptional vineyards in the Clare Valley was being purchased by a large producer who never realised how good the fruit really was. When the time was right we 'stole' it from under their noses!
