




2013 Stolen Block Shiraz

WINEMAKERS NOTES

Sourced from dry grown vineyards that were planted in the 1920's, this Shiraz has layers of succulent fruit with flavours of ripe dark berries and aniseed.

Open fermentation and maturation in new French oak has resulted in a silky mouth feel with sweet vanilla and mocha on the palate. It has well integrated oak with firm, lingering tannins.

Why Stolen Block?

Fruit from one of our most exceptional vineyards in the Clare Valley was being purchased by a large producer who never realised how good the fruit really was. When the time was right we 'stole' it from under their noses!
